Violeta grew up in a single-parent household with a limited income. Though finances were tight, her mother believed in education and motivated her to pursue higher education.

With support from the TRIO Upward Bound Program, Violeta obtained her Associate of Liberal Arts from Trinidad State Junior College, Certificate of Dental Assisting from Pueblo Community College, and Bachelor of Arts in Sociology/Criminology at Colorado State University (CSU) – Pueblo.

Undergoing career changes, Violeta began working as a Student Success Advisor for the TRIO Upward Bound Program at CSU - Pueblo in 2017.

Violeta knew there would be more advancement opportunities if she earned a master's degree so she began her Master of Business Administration program at CSU – Pueblo in 2019. After putting in hard work and receiving CWEF scholarships in 2019 and 2020, **Violeta graduated Magna Cum Laude in 2021**.

Completing her advanced degree facilitated Violeta's **promotion from Student Success Advisor to Assistant Director.** Violeta's promotion came with professional development opportunities and a **\$10,000 raise (24% pay increase).**
